

# There is an impending danger!

**Underground areas are dangerous!**  
 Underground shopping centers, subways, underground parking lots, etc., are mostly in danger since there are limited exits and entrances and also it is very difficult to detect disasters occurring on ground level.

- Anticipated dangers**
- Sudden rush of water to the underground**  
 During heavy rain and floods, water flows underground within a short period of time.
  - Doors will not open due to water pressure**  
 Water pressure due to flooding will be higher than expected, and doors will not open easily.
  - The whole building will have a power outage**  
 Depending on the status of flooding in the underground facilities, the entire building will be out of power and it will be impossible to contact the outside.

**Evacuation points**

**Confirm using the hazard map**  
 Use the hazard map, etc., to know in advance which areas are considered danger zones during heavy rain and flooding.

**Check the weather forecasts**  
 Check the weather forecasts regularly and as much as possible avoid using underground facilities during heavy rain and flooding.

**Vehicles are in danger!**  
 There is a risk of encountering road floods during heavy rain (roads flooded with water).

- Anticipated dangers**
- Heavy rain makes visibility impossible**  
 During heavy rains, the driver will not be able to see ahead and windshield wipers will not be able to cope.
  - Risk of road flooding**  
 The car engine may stop working when driving on a flooded road.
  - Passengers will not be able to get out of the car**  
 In cars stuck in flooded waters, the doors will not open due to water pressure pushing from the outside.

**Evacuation points**

**Gradually slow down the car's speed**  
 If visibility becomes bad due to rain, slow down and do not stop abruptly.

**Do not panic, even if the engine stops**  
 Do not attempt to restart the engine. Turn off the key to prevent electric shocks.

**Break the glass and escape to safety**  
 Always keep a special hammer inside the car, which can be used to break the car windows and escape.
