reinforce if problems are found.

To make the surroundings of the house safe

Roof

Rain gutters, shutters

Make sure that rain gutter joints are not out of position and no fallen leaves, sand, etc., are stuck in side. Check if shutters are aligned properly and repair if problems are found.

Check if roof tiles and antennas are unstable and Veranda

Organize things, re-arrange or secure the placement of flower pots, outdoor airconditioning units that are in danger of falling down.

Propane gas

Place on a sturdy and solid foundation so it doesn't topple over and fix it to the wall with a chain.

Window frame

Do not place flower pots, etc., on the window sills.

Around the entrance

Do not leave bicycles, flower pots, etc., that may obstruct passage through the entrance..

Concrete Wall

Those which have no solid ground foundation or without any reinforcing steel bar, etc., need to be strengthened. Those that are tilting over, with cracks or those with rusted reinforced steel bars need to be repaired.

Points on safety measures for apartments, condominiums, etc.

Pay attention to notifications coming from the building management association

Pay regular attention to notifications made by the building management association regarding disaster prevention facility maintenance, disaster prevention drills, etc. Participate actively in the drills.

Entrance

The entrance is a vital escape route for evacuation. Do not put things in the entrance to ensure unobstructed passsage in times of emergency.

Aisles

Do not place items such as bicycles, etc., to avoid obstructing the evacuation or foot traffic. Also, in order to prevent fires, do not place old newspapers, cardboards, etc., which can easily catch fire.

Veranda evacuation hatch (emergency escape exit)

Carefully check regularly how to use it.
Do not put things around evacuation equipment.

Emergency stairs, emergency doors

Do not put anything that would obstruct foot traffic to ensure a safe evacuation during an emergency. Pay attention especially in front of emergency doors and near the stairs.

Disaster prevention equipment, fire prevention equipment

 Check regularly where fire extinguishers, fire alarms, etc., are placed in common or shared areas such as aisles, etc.
