

Regarding School Subsidies (*Shugaku Enjo Seido* / 就学援助制度)

In addition to elementary and junior high school attendance support systems, Obu City provides economic support for things like school supplies and school lunch fees.

1 Who is Eligible?

- (1) Households receiving Welfare support (*Seikatsu Hogo*)
- (2) Households receiving one of the benefits below, and is recognized by the Obu Board of Education as having financial difficulty equivalent to the standard for welfare support.
 - ① Welfare payments have been suspended or cancelled.
 - ② Municipal taxes have been reduced/exempted.
 - ③ Personal business or property tax has been reduced/exempted.
 - ④ Payments to the national pension plan have been reduced/exempted
 - ⑤ Payments to National Health Insurance have been reduced.
 - ⑥ Receiving Child-rearing allowance.
 - ⑦ Received loan from social assistance fund. (*seikatsu fukushi shikin*)
 - ⑧ Registered as Day Worker with Hello Work. (*shokugyou anteijo touroku hiyatoi roudousha*).
 - ⑨ Other (cases other than those above)

2 Procedure

Guardians who wish to apply for support should prepare the following documents and apply at the School Education Division (2F) at City Hall by February 26th 2021.

Please note that the application form is available at elementary and junior high schools but cannot be submitted through the school.

(1) **School Subsidies Application Form** (第2号様式)

(2) **Power of Attorney** (*ininjō* / 委任状)

※If you are late on other school payments it will be deducted from your school subsidies.

(3) **2020 Income statements** for all members of the household above high school age.

※Copies of Proof of Taxation (***kazei shoumeisho*** / 課税証明書), Proof of Withholding Tax (***gensen choushu*** / 源泉徴収票) or Proof of Income Tax Return (***kakutei shinkokusho*** / 確定申告) etc.

※ Proof must be submitted even if households have no income. If you have not received your year-end tax statements yet, fill in and submit a copy of the Municipal and Provincial Tax Declaration Form (***shiminzei kenminzei shinkokusho*** / 市県民税申告書), available at the Taxation Division counter in City Hall.

(4) **My Number Card** or Notification Card for all household members above high school age.

(5) **Personal Identification (ID)**

※Must include photo (eg. Driver's License)

(6) **Bankbook or Cashcard** for bank account payments.

- (1) School lunch subsidy: monthly debits to the bank account for meal costs will no longer occur.
- (2) The designated disease treatments are for: trachoma (*torakoma*), conjunctivitis (*ketsumakuen*), dermatophytosis (*hakusen*), scabies (*kaisen*), impetigo (*noukashin*), otitis media (*chuujien*), chronic sinusitis (*mansei fukubikuuen*), adenoid (*adenoido*), tooth decay (*ushi*) and verminose including eggs (*kiseichuubyou*).
- (3) The Medical Insurance refers to the JAPAN SPORTS COUNCIL Health Insurance Program (*Kodomo Iryōhi Josei Seido*). Payments for this will be waived (20円 for recipients of welfare, 370円 for others).
- (4) Households without Wi-Fi can borrow routers to support at-home tablet study activities.
- (5) Households receiving welfare (*seikatsu hogo*) are only entitled to subsidies for graduation school trips (*shuugaku ryokō*), PTA fees, designated disease treatments, medical insurance, after-school program (*hōkago club*) and early morning drop off fees (*Sōchō ikusei tesūryō*).
- (6) There may be changes to the details and amounts to the table above (April 2021 School Year)
- (7) The School Subsidies System (*Shgaku enjo seido*) will not cover all expenses charged by your school.
- (8) Deposits to your account will come from 「大府市会計管理者名義」

4 Other (New Student Supplies / *gakuyouhin* / 学用品)

The timing for payments for new student supplies (*gakuyouhin* / 学用品) will depend on when the application was made.

Applications made in February: will be paid late March.

Applications made in March: will be paid late May.

※Applications made after March will not be eligible for the New Student Supplies payment.
