Between January and March this year there were **11** fires in Obu City.

(*In 2025 there were 29 fires, with 2 deaths and 5 persons injured.)

As part of measures to protect precious lives and property from fires, the Obu City Fire Department Headquarters is prioritizing fire prevention awareness activities.

Habit 1



Never smoke in bed, or let someone smoke in bed.

Habit 2



Don't leave burnable materials near a heater. Always turn the heater off before refueling.

Habit 3



Don't leave fire unattended.

Habit 4



Don't overload power sockets with too many plugs. Keep plugs clean.

Measure 1



Use a heater with inbuilt safety functions.

Measure 2



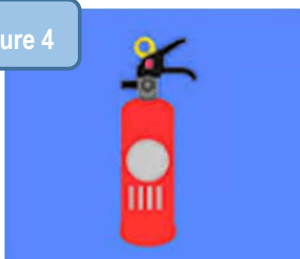
Regularly check your residential fire alarms.

Measure 3



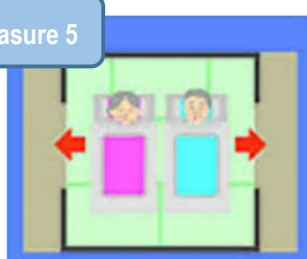
Use fire-retardant products.
